Mr. Bock is a partner in Schnader's Pittsburgh office, chair of its Construction Law Practice Group, and a member of its Litigation Services Department and Real Estate Practice Group. Mr. Bock's practice concentrates in all aspects of construction law, including construction litigation at both trial and appellate levels; alternative dispute resolution (including arbitration and mediation); preparation and negotiation of construction industry contracts on behalf of project owners, contractors and design professionals; and general counseling of construction industry clients.

From 1968 until 1972, Mr. Bock served as a civil engineering officer in the U.S. Air Force. From 1973 through 1987, he worked for the American Bridge, USS Fabrication and USS Realty Development divisions of U.S. Steel Corporation in engineering, contracting, and project management capacities. From 1987 through 1990, Mr. Bock served as project manager for Oxford Development Company and general manager of its in-house construction company.

Mr. Bock has authored numerous articles and papers on construction law topics for professional and trade publications, including those of the ABA Forum on the Construction Industry, the National Business Institute, and the Engineers' Society of Western Pennsylvania. He has also spoken on construction law and alternative dispute resolution topics for these organizations.
